Preventing Extremism and Radicalisation – Easy Read Policy

What This Policy Is About

Llanelli Centre for the Deaf works hard to keep **everyone safe**. We make sure our staff, volunteers, and members are **protected from harm** and **supported**.

We want to **stop people from being influenced by extreme or harmful beliefs** that could lead to violence or intolerance.

Who This Policy Covers

This policy applies to: ✓ Staff, volunteers, trustees, members, and contractors who work with or visit the Centre.

- ✓ Community outreach activities (programs outside the Centre).
- ✓ Young people who might be more vulnerable to radicalisation.
- ✓ People with disabilities especially those who may feel isolated or left out.

What Is Radicalisation?

Radicalisation happens when someone is **influenced by extreme ideas** that could lead to harm, violence, or hatred.

Signs That Someone May Be At Risk

- 准 Talking about extreme or harmful ideas.
- **Becoming withdrawn** or avoiding friends and family.
- Getting angry or upset easily about certain topics.
- **Spending too much time with extreme groups** online or in person.
- Suddenly changing beliefs in a way that seems pressured.

How Llanelli Centre for the Deaf Helps Prevent Radicalisation

1. Training for Staff and Volunteers

All staff and volunteers will learn: \checkmark What Prevent Duty is (laws that help stop radicalisation).

- √ How to spot signs of radicalisation.
- **✓** What to do if they are worried about someone.
- **√** How to create a positive and welcoming environment.
- 2. Keeping a Safe Space
- √ We encourage respectful discussions.
- √ We support people to share their opinions safely.
- ✓ We build **trust and good relationships** with everyone who comes to the Centre.

3. Reporting Concerns

If a staff member or volunteer thinks someone is at risk of radicalisation, they must report it to the **Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)**.
